FAQ

What if my cancer comes back? We will work with the oncology team to help you be seen quickly, if needed.

I just had lab work and imaging, will these be reviewed? Yes, we will review your labs and talk with you about them during your visit.

What if I need imaging or lab work done? We can order any needed labs or imaging and promptly follow up with you about results.

Will my insurance cover the visit? We accept the same insurance as other Duke providers and this visit is covered the same. You may still have a co-pay or deductible.

What if I don't have a primary care provider? We can help you set up care with a primary care provider.

What Should I Expect?

- We work with you to create a complete health plan for your future.
- We provide tailored education for life after cancer treatment.
- We watch for signs that your cancer has come back or a new cancer has developed.
- We evaluate and treat late effects of your cancer and treatment. These may be physical or psychosocial.
- We have direct communication with you, your oncologists, and primary care team to form the best plan for your overall health.
- We connect you with therapists and other health services, as needed.
- We provide referrals to community resources available to you.
- We discuss health promotion behaviors for you to live your best life as a cancer survivor.
